General Instructions & Eligibility

Prerequisites for participation in EIT athletic events



Only currently enrolled **college students** with a valid college ID may participate.



Registration must be completed before the published **Sports Committee** deadline.



Withdrawals after schedule publication without a valid reason lead to **disqualification**.



Players must report **30 minutes** prior to their event as per the schedule.



Proper sports attire and appropriate footwear are **compulsory** for all participants.

Athletics (Men & Women)

Rules for track races, relay exchanges, and field events



Field Events

- Long Jump: Longest of **three valid attempts** counts.
- High Jump: Elimination after **three consecutive** failures.
- Shot Put: Must launch from within the circle without **stepping out**.



Track Events

- False start results in disqualification after **one warning**.
- Athletes must stay within their **assigned lane**.
- Relay exchange must occur within the **marked zone**.



Badminton (Men & Women)

Scoring system and court discipline for singles and doubles



Match format consists of the **Best of 3** games to 21 points each.



Rally scoring system: A point is awarded on **every rally** regardless of serve.



At 20-20, a player must gain a **2-point lead** to win the game.



Players must adhere to **line judge decisions** and shuffle at end changes.



Matches consist of **4 quarters** with duration assigned by the Committee.



Standard violations apply, including **travelling** and **double dribble**.



A player with **5 personal fouls** is disqualified from the game.



Tied games go to **overtime**; Technical fouls for misconduct result in ejection.



Basketball (Men & Women)

Quarters, fouls, and conduct in team basketball

01

Standard competitive time control as per the tournament announcement.

02

Illegal moves result in penalties; repeated illegal moves can result in loss.

03

Players must not distract opponents; absolute silence is required near boards.

04

Objective is to checkmate the opponent's king using 16 commands pieces.

Chess: Strategic Mind Games

Time control and illegal moves in competitive play



Carrom: Board Rules

Scoring points and queen coverage regulations



01 Played as **best of three boards** or until a set point score is reached.



03 Fouls such as **striker pocketing** or improper cover result in penalty points.



02 The **queen** must be pocketed and covered by a piece of the player's color.




04 Players flick a **striker** to pocket carrom men on a **square board**.

Football (Men & Women)


Expulsion rules and referee authority in field matches



Standard 11-a-side match with two halves (duration by Committee).



Rules for offside, throw-ins, corner kicks, and penalties strictly apply.



Yellow Card for caution and Red Card for expulsion are enforced.



Persistent dissent or disrespecting referee signals leads to expulsion.



Kabaddi: Contact Play

Raider protocols and scoring bonus points




Raider must enter the opponent's half and declare '**kabaddi**' in a single breath.



Raids must start from the **own half**; players are out on valid tags.



Teams earn extra points when **all opponents** are declared 'out'.



Intentional roughness or dangerous contact is strictly prohibited.

Table Tennis: Scoring Metrics

Key figures for competitive game play and set wins

11

Game Points

Points required to win a single game.

5

Match Format

Best of 5 games to determine the overall winner.

2

Deuce Margin

Point lead required if tied at 10-10.

2

Service Rotation


Service alternates every two points.

Volleyball (Men & Women)

Set rules and touch violations on the court

Unsportsmanlike conduct, such as shouting at officials, leads to technical penalties.

Net contact and rotation violations result in immediate point loss.



Best of 3 sets: **25 points** per set (deciding set is **15 points**).

Three touches per side allowed; Note that a block does not count as a touch.

Medical & Safety Protocols

Ensuring athlete wellbeing throughout the competition

A **First-aid team** is available at all venues during active play.

Participants compete at their **own risk**; hazard behavior is forbidden.

Abuse, violence, or **unsportsmanlike conduct** results in disqualification.

Consumption of **banned substances** on campus is strictly prohibited.

Damage to facilities must be compensated by the responsible team/individual.
